The mission of the Hotel/Non-Profit Collaborative is to facilitate the successful donation of usable, excess goods, supplies and equipment from area hotels and businesses to community based non-profit service agencies. Examples of donations include furniture, computers, clothing and food. This is a grass-roots organization that averages more than 10,000 pounds of donated materials per month. Not only is this good for the environment because it diverts so many serviceable goods from the waste stream but it also gives back to the community by supporting our local non-profit agencies that serve those in need.

The Hotel Council of San Francisco is an active member of the Collaborative. We are proud to encourage our members to support their mission and assist in identifying and partnering with local non-profits.

The San Francisco Hotel/Non-profit Collaborative was started over 10 years ago by Jo Licata, Community Projects Manager at the Hilton San Francisco, and has continued to be organized and maintained through the Hilton San Francisco. There are now almost 20 large properties, as well as the Moscone Center and other hospitality businesses and well over 20 non-profit organizations that meet on a monthly basis as part of the Hotel/Non-Profit Collaborative. Some of the non-profit organizations that have benefited from the Collaborative are Glide Memorial Church, St. Anthony Dining Room, Food Runners and Florence Crittenton Services.
